

Citizen Vendor Style Guide for Jewelmate Point of Sale

Citizen has created their vendor style numbers in such a way that each variation of a particular design is accounted for, so there is no need to customize your numbers with metal colors, gemstones, sizes, or other information. Please use the attached pdf as a guide to better understand Citizen's style numbers and how correct entry helps you and your sales representative better identify the items that you're selling.

In addition, Citizen does offer a digital catalog with their correct style numbers with images. Only the images can be imported into Jewelmate.

The correct style number for Citizen is entered in the Vendor Style# field: BL5600-53E

Examples of incorrectly entered style numbers include: BL5600-53E-GEN-E, BL5600, BL5600-53E-GEN

Jewelmate will auto populate any SKU that has been received before – be careful of using this as you begin to correct any previously bad entries.

Citizen does not use serial numbers.
