

David Weisz Vendor Style Guide

for DCIT Point of Sale

David Weisz has created their vendor style numbers in such a way that each variation of a particular design is accounted for, so there is no need to customize your numbers with metal colors, gemstones, sizes, or other information.

Ex: TSP- three-stone pendant FSP- five stone pendant BET - bezel earring three piece, BTP- bezel three stone pendants, NEC- necklace, RIN- ring. All these three leers are followed by a series of four random letters.

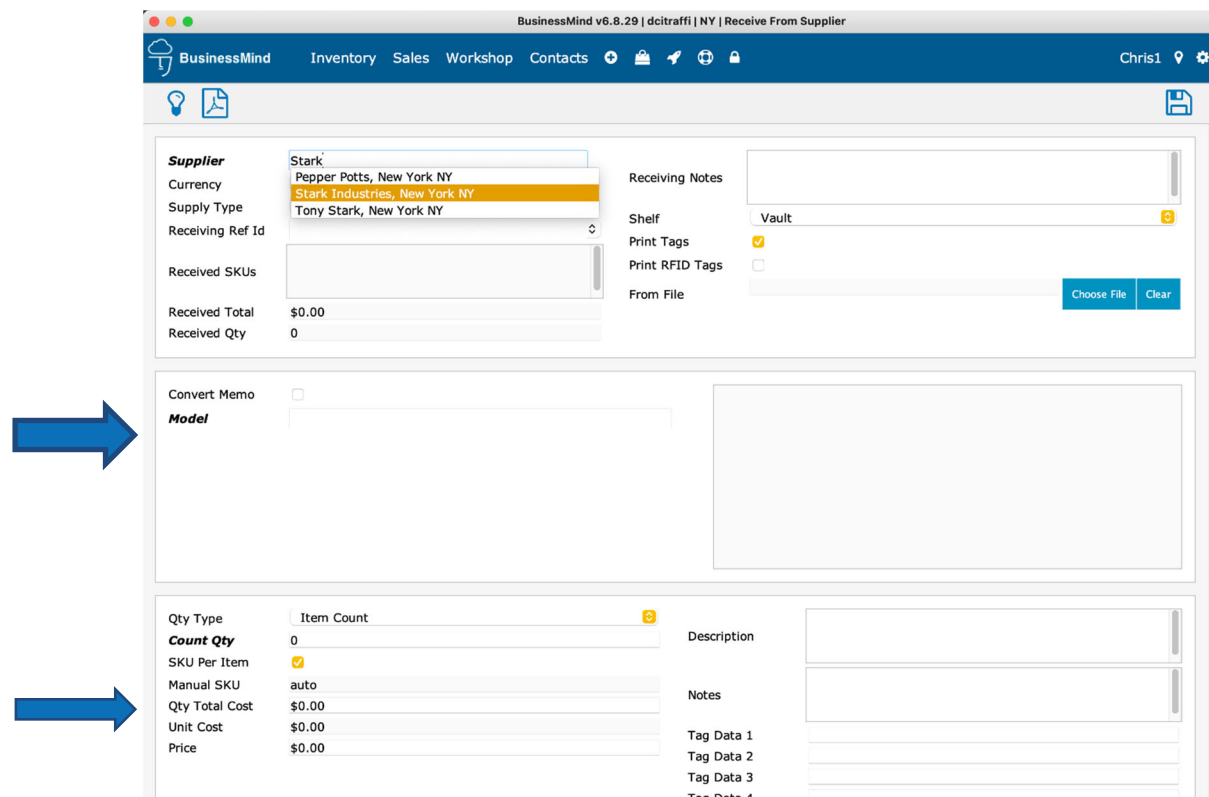
The correct style number for David Weisz is entered in the Model # field: RIN-1234

Examples of incorrectly entered style numbers: RN1234, RN/1234, RN-1234 14KW

DCIT will auto populate any SKU that has been received before – be careful of using this as you begin to correct any previously bad entries.

DCIT recommends checking the “SKU Per Item” box for David Weisz serial numbers and typing the serial number, as a “Manual SKU” instead of “auto”. It is advised to make this a required field.

DCIT also gives you the ability to receive your inventory as a csv file, please contact them directly for more information.
