

True Romance Vendor Style Guide

for Edge Point of Sale

True Romance has created their vendor style numbers in such a way that each variation of a particular design is accounted for, so there is no need to customize your numbers with metal colors, gemstones, sizes, or other information.

The correct style number for True Romance is entered in the Vendor Style # field: WR977E/E14WG

Examples of incorrectly entered style numbers include: WR977, WR977/E, WR977/E-E 14WG

Edge will auto populate any SKU that has been received before – be careful of using this as you begin to correct any previously bad entries.

True Romance does not use serial numbers.

In Edge, if you wish to account for an item that is custom made for a customer, you can use the “Style Note” field for this information, maintaining the integrity of the style number on your invoice. If the item is a special order, you will use the “Stock Type” field to record that and allocate the item to the customer.
