

BIG POS Guide David Weisz - DCIT

David Weisz has created their vendor style numbers in such a way that each variation of a particular design is accounted for, so there is no need to customize your numbers with metal colors, gemstones, sizes, or other information. Please see the attached guide for reading **David Weisz's** style numbers.

The correct **style number** for **David Weisz** is entered in the Model # field: **1001-A**

Examples of incorrectly entered style numbers include: **1001, 1001A, S/O 1001 size 7**

DCIT will auto populate any SKU that has been received before – be careful of using this as you begin to correct any previously bad entries.

DCIT recommends checking the “SKU Per Item” box for **David Weisz** items with **item numbers** and typing the item number, as a “Manual SKU” instead of “auto”. It is advised to make this a required field.
